

## **2019 Pool Rules and Regulations**

**THE POOL WILL OPEN SATURDAY, MAY 25, 2019  
AND WILL CLOSE MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2019.**

**The Board of Trustees must adhere to all Milford Health Department and State Health Department rules and regulations in order to operate our pool.**

**The Board of Trustees whose obligation is to enforce the rules and regulations necessary to effectively manage the pool for all residents has adopted these Rules and Regulations, as well as all governmental rules and regulations.**

These Rules and Regulations are necessary for the comfort and safety of the Milford Country Club Residents and your guests. You can help by knowing these rules. The lifeguards' job is to guard the pool and to maintain order.

Lifeguards are not to be distracted by residents gathering around the lifeguard station (table).

Lifeguards will be taking a 15 minute break every hour to check the pool chemicals. During this time, the pool must be cleared from all residents and guests.

**Any questions or comments should be directed to the Management Company, not to the lifeguards, who cannot change Rules.**

**HOURS:** Pool Hours will be Monday-Friday from: 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Weekends & Holidays from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The pool will only be open on the weekends until June 21st, aside from Memorial Day. After June 21st, it will be open daily, weather permitting.

**POOL PASSES:** Upon entering the pool area you must show your pool pass. If you do not have your pool pass when entering the pool, the lifeguard cannot let you enter the pool. This rule is in place to keep our residents safe and our pool area clean. You may pick up your pool pass at the MCCC office.

**Please make sure to pick up your pool pass at the office during office hours.** If you cannot make it to the office during normal business hours, please call the office (508-478-1250) and we will make arrangements to accommodate you.

**GENERAL RULES**

**AGE REGULATIONS:** All children 12 YEARS OLD AND UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN who must take an active part in controlling the child's behavior. This includes obeying the Pool Rules and Regulations.

(1) Children between the ages of 13 and 16, who are good swimmers, may swim without parents or guardians accompanying them. A statement of age and permission must be on file at the Management Office.

(2) The children must show their responsibility and independence by obeying all Pool Rules and Regulations.

Children unaccompanied by a parent or guardian may not bring guests.

**GUESTS:** An **adult** resident accompany their guest(s) at all times while in the pool area. This is to ensure that the guests follow all the rules. In all cases the resident is the responsible party. A parent or guardian must accompany all guests under the age of 16. Any deviation requires permission of the management company and the Board of Trustees.

The capacity of the pool is 65.

If the pool is overcrowded, the lifeguard will need to ask some of the guests to leave.

**Lifeguards and the Management Company** have the responsibility and authority to direct ANYONE involved in misconduct to leave the pool area.

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**Entrance to the pool is through the pool gates, not through the clubhouse. You will need to check in with the lifeguard at the entrance of the pool gate.**

**The restrooms can be accessed through the clubhouse door directly from the pool. Please be advised, there is also access to the bathroom on the sides of the clubhouse. These side entrances will be used if there is a clubhouse rental.**

The Association is not responsible for the loss of personal property left in the pool area, or personal damage or injury if safe conduct or behavior is violated.

## **SAFETY REGULATIONS**

1. Except for life jackets, no toys or flotation devices are permitted in the pool.
2. Pool privileges may be denied by the lifeguard when behavior becomes unruly.
3. **No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.**
4. Lifeguards are responsible for closing the pool during storms, overcrowding, safety hazards, or when the water needs treatment.
5. Radios are permitted only when used with headsets.
6. No running, horseplay, fighting, yelling or abusive conduct is allowed.
7. Diving into the pool is not permitted.
8. No smoking in pool area.

## **SANITARY REGULATIONS**

- 1: No one with a skin, eye, nose, throat or other infection, or any ailment considered communicable will be allowed to use the pool.
- 2: Everyone must shower before using the pool.
- 3: Children must wear swimmies.
- 4: Only bathing suits may be worn in the pool. Bathing caps may be required for those with long hair.
- 5: Pets are not permitted in the pool area.

The Management Company, the lifeguards, and the Board of Trustees reserve the right to deny the privilege of the use of the facilities to anyone not obeying the Rules and Regulations.

Please respect the pool, and the staff. Please be sensitive to the views of your neighbors, and most importantly, help us to provide a safe and enjoyable facility.
